Minutes of the meeting held on 26.08.25

1. Welcoming Committee Members

Dr. Sabitha Gokulraj, Director In Charge warmly welcomed all committee members and informed them that Prof. Dr. P.K. Sudhir, Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. J. Sabarinathan, Pro Vice Chancellor, Prof. Dr. A. Nagappan, Registrar were unable to attend due to another official meeting.

She further informed the participants that a new IQAC committee was constituted in July 2025, with a two-year tenure from 2025 to 2027. She emphasized the committee's focus on Inclusivity, Quality enhancement, and Collaborative efforts for the continuous development of the university.

Dr. Sabitha extended her gratitude to all members for accepting to serve as the VMRF(DU) IQAC committee member and encouraged active discussions and deliberations toward the university's growth. The meeting commenced with the agenda.

Dr. Rajan Samuel, Director – Academics, highlighted the significance of fostering a culture of quality across Curriculum, Teaching, Infrastructure, and Research Outputs. He also emphasized the importance of aligning institutional goals with the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals.

2.Introduction of new IQAC Members

All committee members, including administrators, faculty, students, alumni, industry representatives, and employers, introduced themselves and shared their backgrounds. They expressed strong commitment to the mission and objectives of the IQAC.

Dr. S.A.V Satyamurthy, Director – Research, reaffirmed that research contributions would continuously support the university's Accreditation and Ranking efforts.

3. Actions taken on the Previous Meeting

A review of the action points from the previous meeting held on 28.02.2025 was conducted and passed. Key achievements by the Accreditation and Ranking Cell were discussed. Successful submission to NIRF, AQAR 2023–2024, Times Higher Education and Recognition received in IIRF and other National and Global rankings was conveyed.

4. Upcoming National Conference on Accreditation (January 2026)

The university's Accreditation and Ranking Cell is planning to host a National Conference on 21st January, 2026 as a part of the university's Silver Jubilee celebrations.

The conference will focus on preparedness for the new NAAC draft and is expected to feature 3 to 4 expert lectures in a comprehensive one-day format.

The Director of Research recommended including workshops on QS and Times Higher Education rankings.

Members agreed to prioritize sessions on the new NAAC draft.

Future sessions would address other global rankings and accreditation frameworks.

5. Discussion on Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs)

Dr. Rajan Samuel informed that the university has prioritized the following SDGs for focused implementation:

SDG 3: Good Health and Well-being,

SDG 4: Quality Education,

SDG 7: Affordable and Clean Energy,

SDG 13: Climate Action

SDG 17: Partnerships for the Goals

A plan is in place to involve all constituent institutions in Mapping their academic and operational activities to the relevant SDGs. It was proposed that each institution be encouraged to identify and focus on additional SDGs aligned with their strengths and strategic interests.

Mr. P. Rajasekaran, informed the committee that the management is working on a software to systematically map and document institutional activities aligned with the SDGs.

6. Any Other with Permission of the Chairperson

Representatives from the industry and employer sectors emphasized their willingness to support health-related initiatives and emotional well-being programs and expressed their positive intent to actively contribute to the implementation and progress of SDG-related initiatives in collaboration with the university.

The meeting concluded by vote of thanks by Dr. Sabitha Gokulraj who thanked Prof. Dr. P.K. Sudhir, Vice Chancellor VMRF(DU), Prof. Dr. J. Sabarinathan, Pro Vice Chancellor VMRF(DU), Prof. Dr. A. Nagappan, Registrar VMRF(DU) who have been the support of all the university activities and all members for their valuable input and active participation. She reiterated the importance of continuous engagement and collaboration to achieve the strategic goals of the IQAC and the university at large.
