## **Duties and Responsibilities of Full Time Research Scholars**

### 1. Eligibility & Scope

 Full-time research scholars are eligible for Ph.D. fellowships and have additional academic responsibilities compared to part-time research scholars.

### 2. Attendance Requirement

- Must be present on all working days at the Institution where the Research Supervisor is employed.
- 100% attendance (excluding public holidays and Sundays) is expected; however, a minimum of 85% attendance per year is mandatory

## 3. Research Progress Review

- o Must present progress reports to the Research Advisory Committee (RAC) every six months from the date of registration.
- Two half-yearly progress reports cannot be submitted simultaneously.

# 4. Commitment & Withdrawal Policy

- Must submit an undertaking to complete research and submit the thesis after a minimum of three years.
- If a scholar leaves the program without approval before thesis submission or three years
  of study, they must repay the Ph.D. fellowship and contingency grants received.
- o The University reserves the right to initiate **disciplinary action** in such cases.

# 5. **Publication Requirement**

 A minimum of two papers must be published in indexed journals during the research period and 2 conference paper presentations.

## 6. Curriculum Development Participation

 May contribute to curriculum and learning resource development for UG/PG programs, working alongside faculty members.

### 7. Mentorship & Professional Role Preparation

May support faculty in professional development roles and mentor junior students.

### 8. Time Commitment

 Expected to devote at least two-thirds of their daily time to research activities to ensure timely completion of the Ph.D.

## 9. Learning Research Methods

 Must develop strong command over disciplinary theories, practices, and research methodologies and apply them effectively.

# 11. Ethical Conduct

- Must uphold high ethical standards in all research-related activities (data collection, analysis, presentation).
- o Adherence to **University's research guidelines** is mandatory.

## 12. Scholarly Engagement & University Affiliation

- o Expected to actively participate in seminars, conferences, workshops, colloquia, etc.
- All research publications must clearly carry University affiliation, whether individual or joint, especially during the fellowship tenure.

#### 13. No Evaluation Duties

 Full-time research scholars are not permitted to engage in examination or evaluationrelated responsibilities.

# 14. Research & Consultancy Roles

 May undertake research and consultancy/supervisory work either independently or in collaboration with department faculty.

#### 15. Institutional Involvement

- o Encouraged to understand academic and administrative functioning by contributing to:
  - Program design
  - Project proposal preparation
  - Development of new academic initiatives

# 16. Maternity Leave (for Female Scholars)

- Entitled to maternity leave of up to 240 days (without fellowship) during the minimum research period.
- o This leave period will **extend the minimum duration** for thesis submission.
- Fellowship will resume upon return and continue until the minimum period is completed.

### 17. Compliance & Documentation

 Scholars must remain aware of and comply with University policies, completing all required documentation and processes on time.

### 18. Assigned Duties

 Must undertake and complete specific academic or research-related tasks assigned by the Head of Institution (Hol).

### 19. Community & Societal Engagement

- Expected to contribute to:
  - Institution-Industry-Society interactions
  - Community development programs
  - Rural development support
  - Entrepreneurial initiatives
  - Dissemination of knowledge and technical assistance in areas of social relevance

# 20. Joint Research Opportunities

May engage in joint research and consultancy with their Research Supervisor.
