

Refund of Fees details

- The student shall remit the prescribed fees including tuition fee, examination fee, etc., to the University within the specified date. They will have to pay the fee along with a penalty for late payment, as may be specified by the University.
- The University reserves the right to revise the fee structure, including tuition fees, hostel fees, and other applicable charges, from time to time based on the recommendations or decisions of the appropriate authorities. Any revision in tuition fees shall be applicable only to students admitted in the academic session for which such revision is notified. However, revisions in other fees shall be applicable to all students with effect from the date of notification.
- If a student withdraws from the course before the prescribed admission cut-off date and the vacated seat is filled by another candidate, 10% of the tuition fee paid will be deducted. The remaining balance will be refunded to the student via wire transfer within three weeks. The Office of International Relations will process the refund.
- If any candidate withdraws from the course of study after the expiry of the cut-off date prescribed for admission to that course of study or in mid-term of the course and the seat is rendered vacant, the first year fee paid will be forfeited and the student will also be required to remit the entire course fee for the remaining period of the course.
- Even after the expiry of the date fixed for payment with penalty, if any student fails to pay the tuition fee, the student will not be permitted to attend the classes.
