### **Faculty of Medicine:**

<b>Programme</b>	<b>Eligibility</b>
MBBS	<p>i. To be eligible for admission to MBBS Degree Course, a candidate must have passed in 10+2 / H.Sc. (or) its equivalent examination with subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology at the Qualifying Examination prescribed by NMC and in addition, must have come in the merit list of NEET -UG for admission to MBBS Degree Course.</p> <p>ii. In respect of the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC categories, the marks obtained in PCB / Biotechnology taken together in the qualifying Examinations must be 40% marks instead of 50%. In respect of candidates with PWD (Persons with Disabilities) the minimum marks shall be 45% for general and 40% for SC/ST/OBC category.</p> <p>iii. In order to become eligible for admission to MBBS Degree Course for a particular academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of 50th percentile marks in NEET UG. However, in respect of candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC category the minimum marks must be 40<sup>th</sup> percentile and PWD (Persons with Disabilities) candidates the minimum marks shall be 45<sup>th</sup> Percentile for general category and 40<sup>th</sup> Percentile for SC/ST/OBC category.</p> <p>Candidate shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission.</p>

### **Faculty of Dentistry:**

<b>Programme</b>	<b>Eligibility</b>
BDS	<p>i. To be eligible for admission to BDS Degree Course, a candidate must have passed in 10+2 / H.Sc (or) its equivalent examination with subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology at the Qualifying Examination prescribed by DCI and in addition must have come in the merit list of NEET UG.</p> <p>ii. In respect of the candidate belonging to SC/ ST / OBC category, the marks to be obtained is 40% instead of 50%. In respect of candidates with PWD (Persons with Disabilities) the minimum marks at 45% for general and 40% for SC / ST / OBC category. In order to become eligible for admission to BDS Degree Course for a particular academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50<sup>th</sup> percentile in NEET UG.</p> <p>iii. However, in respect of candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC category the minimum marks 40<sup>th</sup> percentile and PWD (Persons with Disabilities) candidates, the minimum marks 45<sup>th</sup> Percentile for general category and 40<sup>th</sup> percentile for SC / ST / OBC category.</p> <p>Candidate shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission.</p>



### Faculty of Homoeopathy:

BHMS	<p>i. To be eligible for admission to BHMS Degree Course, a candidate must have passed in 10+2 / H.Sc. (or) its equivalent examination with subjects of Physics, chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology and English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% Marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry, Biology / Biotechnology at the Qualifying Examination as prescribed by NCH and in addition, must have come in the merit list of NEET - UG for admission to BHMS Degree Course. In respect of the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC categories, the marks obtained in PCB / Biotechnology taken together in the qualifying Examinations must be 40% marks instead of 50%. In respect of candidates with PWD (Persons with Disabilities) the minimum marks shall be 45% for general and 40% for SC/ST/OBC category.</p> <p>ii. In order to become eligible for admission to BHMS Degree Course for a particular academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of 50<sup>th</sup> percentile marks in NEET UG. However, in respect of candidates belonging to SC/ ST/OBC category the minimum marks must be 40th percentile and PWD (Persons with Disabilities) candidates the minimum marks shall be 45<sup>th</sup> Percentile for general category and 40<sup>th</sup> Percentile for SC/ST/OBC category.</p> <p>Candidate shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission.</p>

Pharmacy	<p>A pass in 10+2 / H.Sc. or its equivalent Examination with Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany &amp; Zoology) or Mathematics and English individually and must have obtained PCB/PCM minimum aggregate marks 40% and 35 % marks in case of SC / ST category.</p> <p>Candidate shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission.</p>
Pharm. D (6 Years)	<p>A pass in 10+2 / H.Sc. or its equivalent Examination with Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany &amp; Zoology) Mathematics.</p> <p>Candidate shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission.</p>

### Faculty of Nursing:

Programme	Eligibility
B.Sc ( Nursing)	<p>A pass in 10+2 / H.Sc or its equivalent Examination with Physics, Chemistry, Biology (Botany &amp; Zoology) and English individually and must have obtained a minimum aggregate marks of 45% in case of SC / ST category 40% marks.</p> <p>Age: The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years.</p>



### Faculty of Physiotherapy:

BPT	A pass in 10+2 / H.Sc or its equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry and Biology (Botany & Zoology)  Candidate shall complete the age of 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission.

LLB (Hons)	A Pass in any Bachelor's degree from a recognized University or an Equivalent Institution recognized as deemed to be University or from a foreign University declared as equivalent to an Indian degree by a competent. (Not less than 45% marks for General Category, 42% for OBC and 40% for SC/ST)
