EXAMINATIONS REFORMS

1. The examinations halls of all the Institutions of the University shall be connected during examinations with the office of the Controller of Examinations through CCTV soon.
2. The details of the Degrees awarded are being furnished to the National Academic Depository (NAD) from 2018 onwards.
3. Previous ERP software is replaced with new cloud software CAMU of Octoze Technologies in the year 2016-17. The students and parents are having the benefits of knowing their academic credits through the MY CAMU Application.
4. Question papers of previous examinations of all the courses are uploaded on the university website, for the benefit of students.
5. Sending encrypted question papers through online with password protection to the Chief Superintendent of the respective examinations on the day of the examinations from 2017-18 onwards. Shared the password contains two parts, one part Alphabets and second part Numerical numbers. Before $\frac{1}{2}$ hour of the examination, one part is shared to the Chief Superintendent and the other part to the HOI or senior faculty nominated by HOI. The question papers can be opened only after entering the two parts of the passwords by the two members. The required number of question papers are printed in the presence of Chief Superintendent, Observer (Nominated by COE) and one senior most invigilator of that day in a confidential room and made use off. Immediately in the prescribed proforma the details of the printing of the Question papers printed etc, is filled, counter signed by all the three members. Scanned copy of the same is to be sent by E-mail to COE office within maximum of half an hour. This is working successfully.
6. The questions banks are provided by the staff of Engineering, Arts & Science and is updated in the system. The questions bank consists of ten times the questions required for each part. On the day of the examinations, question papers shall be drawn from the question bank for each course, by using predesigned and tested software in the computer.

7. Examination fees collection from the students is being made through online mode through Paytm from 2018 onwards and is going on successfully.
8. As per the UGC guidelines the photograph of the student is being printed on the degree certificate from 2018 onwards and on Hall Tickets as well. More number of security features are incorporated in Degree certificates & Grade sheets.
9. Issuing Degree under "In Advance "category is introduced for those who need the certificate immediately from 2016 onwards, subjected to proper justification.
10. In Faculty of Engineering, Outcome Based Education (OBE) from 2017-18, in Faculty of Medicine, Competency Based Medical Education (CBME) from 2019-20 and in few of the Arts and Science programmes Learning Outcome Based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) from 2020-21 have been introduced. Examination section has been adopted accordingly.
11. Internal marks are entered online by the concerned faculty in CAMU portal.
12. The marks awarded during central evaluation shall be entered in the system immediately. Print out of the same shall be endorsed by the concerned examiners.
